- 3) See well status definitions in the table below and select the appropriate status designation.

Well Status	Status Definition
Active	The well is currently in use for its intended purpose (e.g., irrigation, domestic supply, industrial use).
Inactive	The well is not currently in use but has not been permanently decommissioned. It may be brought back into service in the future.
Standby	The well is maintained and operational but is not regularly used. It can be activated as needed, often for backup or emergency purposes.
Abandoned	The well is no longer in use and has been properly sealed and decommissioned in accordance with regulatory requirements.
